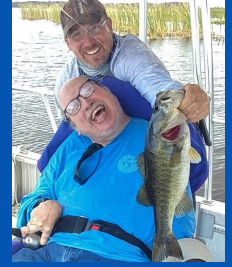




StirringWaters Charity Bass Tournament
